United States Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg was appointed to the Supreme Court in 1993. She served until her death in 2020. Prior to her appointment, Professor Ginsburg argued several cases before the Supreme Court. Her passion was equality. In her final year, she recounted some of her decisions and dissents on the bench. Her new book, *Decisions and Dissents of Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg: A Selection* demonstrates the exorbitant cost of disobeying the law—litigation. She won several cases and includes her unique experience to present her side, developed in a series by Penguin Liberty. Once determined by her impartial position on the Supreme Court, these decisions and dissents are now used to advocate for women. Throughout her career she wished to discard phony pedestals lent to women by sexist laws and rules, and has left her influence for all.
